ORDER

Pending in this case is Defendants renewed motion to dismiss Plaintiff's complaint, doc. 30, and a supporting memorandum of law, doc. 31, with exhibits. A motion to intervene has now been filed by another *pro se* litigant, Philip Stoddard. Doc. 38. Mr. Stoddard has also submitted a complaint, doc. 39. Defendants and Plaintiff Hason shall have until **June 20, 2006**, in which to respond to the motion to intervene.

Additionally, Plaintiff Hason has requested additional time to respond to the pending motion to dismiss. Plaintiff Hason shall have until **June 20, 2006**, to respond to the renewed motion to dismiss as well.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. Plaintiff Hason shall file a response to the renewed motion to dismiss, doc. 30, filed by Defendants on or before **June 20, 2006**.

2. **Failure to comply with this Court order may result in a recommendation of dismissal of this action.**

3. The parties shall have until **June 20, 2006**, in which to file opposition to the motion to intervene.

4. Ruling is **DEFERRED** on the renewed motion to dismiss, doc. 30, and motion to intervene, doc. 38.

5. The Clerk of Court shall return this file to the undersigned no later than June 20, 2006.
